

# NIHONDAIRA YUME TERRACE



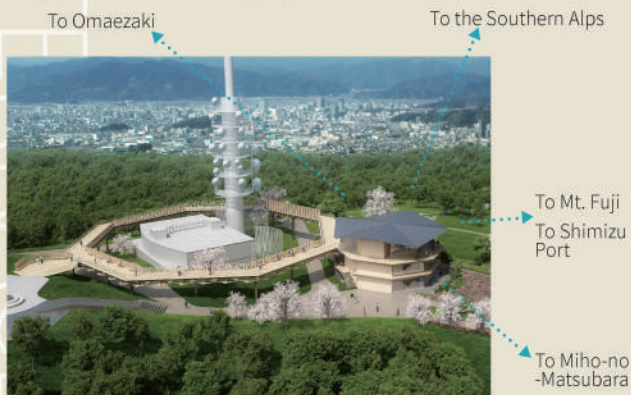
Learn about the rich history and cultural value of Nihondaira, set against the backdrop of some of Japan's most spectacular scenery.

Get blown away by the incredible 360° panoramic view overlooking Mt. Fuji and iconic spots including Suruga Bay, the deepest and most beautiful bay in Japan, Shimizu Port, Miho-no-Matsubara, Izu Peninsula, the Southern Alps, and more. Enjoy the ever-changing scenery of Mt. Fuji in different seasons; 24 hours, 365 days a year.

Learn about the fascinating history of Nihondaira on the 1st floor through interactive touch panels and informative displays. Make yourself comfortable in the lounge area on the 2nd floor. Prepare yourself before heading up to the observation deck, where breathtaking scenery fitting of its name "Yume Terrace" (Dream Terrace) awaits.

The stunning 360° open-air observation deck features gorgeous views of Mt. Fuji, Suruga Bay, Miho-no-Matsubara, and more.

Open till 9pm on Saturdays, so don't miss the chance to enjoy the breathtaking night views.



## Getting here



### 【 By car 】

- Approx. 30 min. from Shizuoka I.C. on Tomei Expressway
- Approx. 30 min. from Shimizu I.C. on Tomei Expressway
- Approx. 35 min. from Shin-Shizuoka I.C. on Shin-Tomei Expressway
- ※ Parking (free) 140 standard sized cars, 20 large buses

### 【 By Tokaido Shinkansen 】

- Approx. 25 min. by taxi from JR Shizuoka Station
- Approx. 40 min by bus from JR Shizuoka Station (North Exit, Bus Stop No. 11)
- ※ Take the Nihondaira Line bus heading towards Nihondaira Ropeway, alight at "Nihondaira Sekihi-mae" and walk for approx. 5 min.

### 【 By Tokaido Line 】

- Approx. 20 min. by taxi from JR Shimizu Station
- Approx. 10 min. by taxi from JR Higashi-Shizuoka Station
- Approx. 25 min. by bus from JR Higashi-Shizuoka Station (South Exit)
- ※ Take the Nihondaira Line bus heading towards Nihondaira Ropeway, alight at "Nihondaira Sekihi-mae" and walk for approx. 5 min.

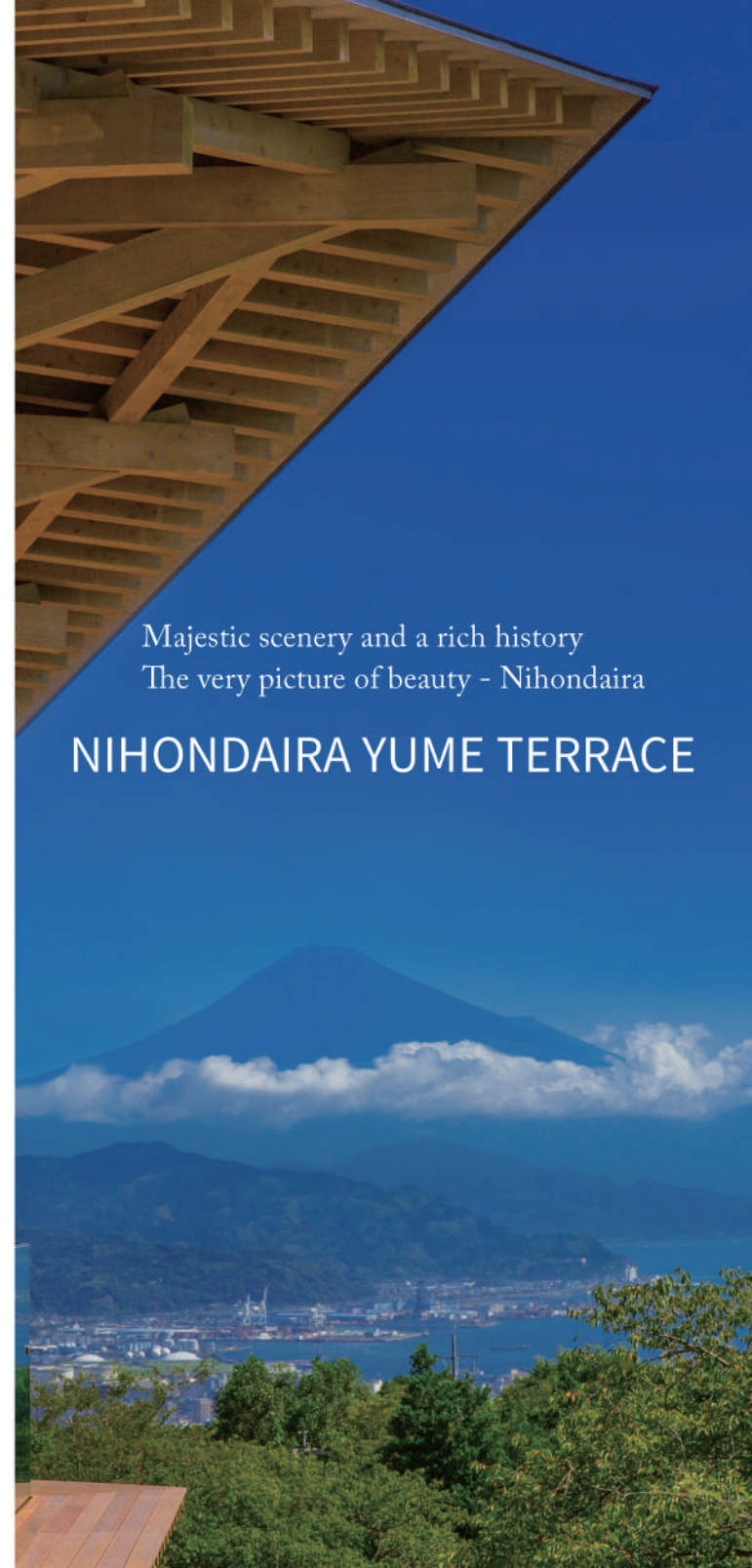

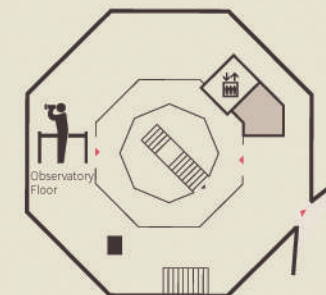

### Introduction

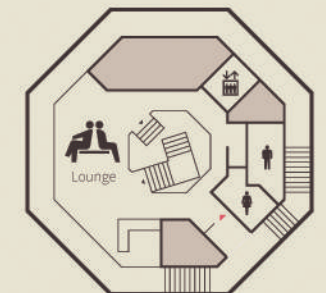

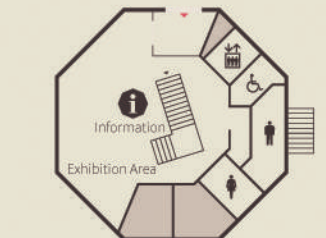
